

The Nebraska Vietnam Veterans Memorial Foundation (NVMF) invites you to join the Honor 400 Campaign, a statewide fundraising campaign supporting NVVMF's mission to make a Nebraska Vietnam Veterans Memorial a reality. The campaign will launch to the public on March 29, 2023.

NVVMF is an all-volunteer nonprofit organization, formed to develop, construct and maintain a memorial dedicated to the memory and sacrifices of all Nebraska Vietnam Veterans and provide a historical account for future generations. The Memorial will be located in Papillion, Nebraska. More information can be found at www.nvvmf.org.

The goal of the Honor 400 Campaign is to raise \$400,000, statewide, in support of the Memorial. To achieve this, Sponsors in all parts of the state are needed to assist NVVMF in raising \$1,000 for each of the 400 Nebraskans Killed-In-Action during the Vietnam War.

What is an Honor 400 Sponsor?

Sponsors provide gifts to their county or region's campaign, or to the overall statewide effort. These lead gifts will provide incentive and encouragement to other businesses, organizations, and individuals to give their own gifts in support of the Nebraska KIAs. Ideally, total sponsorship donations will comprise 50% of the monetary goal of any county, region, or the statewide goal.

Region 1: Panhandle

This region includes Banner, Box Butte, Cheyenne, Dawes, Deuel, Garden, Kimball, Morrill, Scotts Bluff, Sheridan, and Sioux counties.

There are 25 KIA from the Panhandle Region, including Box Butte (2), Cheyenne (3), Dawes (2), Deuel (1), Morrill (1), Scotts Bluff (12), and Sheridan (4) counties.

Region 2: West Central Plains

This region includes Arthur, Chase, Cherry, Dundy, Grant, Hayes, Hitchcock, Hooker, Keith, Lincoln, Logan, McPherson, Perkins, and Thomas counties.

There are 29 KIA from the West Central Region, including Arthur (1), Cherry (2), Dundy (1), Hitchcock (2), Hooker (1), Keith (6), Lincoln (12), Perkins (2), and Thomas (2) counties.

Region 3: North Central Plains

This region includes Antelope, Blaine, Boone, Boyd, Brown, Garfield, Holt, Keya Paha, Knox, Loup, Nance, Pierce, Rock and Wheeler counties.

There are 25 KIA from the North Central Region, including Antelope (3), Boone (2), Boyd (1), Brown (1), Holt (3), Knox (11), Pierce (3), and Rock (1) counties.

Region 4: Central Plains

This region includes Buffalo, Custer, Dawson, Greeley, Hall, Howard, Sherman, and Valley counties.

There are 31 KIA from Buffalo (4), Custer (3), Dawson (9), Greeley (2), Hall (7), Howard (1), Sherman (2), and Valley (3) counties.

Region 5: South Central Plains

This region includes Adams, Franklin, Frontier, Furnas, Gosper, Harlan, Kearney, Phelps, Red Willow, and Webster counties.

There are 31 KIA from Adams (5), Franklin (1), Frontier (1), Furnas (5), Gosper (2), Harlan (3), Kearney (1), Phelps (5), Red Willow (7), and Webster (1) counties.

Region 6: Northeast

This region includes Burt, Cedar, Cuming, Dakota, Dixon, Madison, Stanton, Thurston, and Wayne counties.

There are 32 KIA from Burt (2), Cedar (8), Cuming (4), Dixon (2), Madison (9), Stanton (1), Thurston (3), and Wayne (3) counties.

Region 7: Platte

This region includes Colfax, Dodge, Platte, Saunders, and Washington counties.

There are 25 KIA from Colfax (1), Dodge (11), Platte (6), Saunders (4), and Washington (3) counties

Region 8: South Platte

This region includes Butler, Clay, Fillmore, Hamilton, Jefferson, Merrick, Nuckolls, Polk, Saline, Seward, Thayer, and York counties.

There are 26 KIA from Butler (1), Clay (3), Fillmore (3), Hamilton (1), Merrick (3), Nuckolls (4), Polk (1), Saline (2), Seward (2), Thayer (3), and York (3) counties.

Region 9: Southeast

This region includes Cass, Gage, Johnson, Nemaha, Otoe, Pawnee, and Richardson counties.

There are 27 KIA from Cass (7), Gage (3), Johnson (3), Nemaha (2), Otoe (7), and Richardson (5) counties.

Region 10: Omaha - Lincoln Metro

This region includes Douglas, Lancaster, and Sarpy counties.

There are 149 KIA from Sarpy (5), Lancaster (45), and Douglas (99) counties.
